NEW GILLBT VERNACULAR MEDIA STUDIO

With a high % of the population unable to read and write we are giving oral learners the access to audio/video scripture tools in their mother tongue that empower them to make disciples of their extended households.

We are very excited about what is happening as we apply what we learned from the Jonathan Training that we helped facilitate in Burkina Faso last February. We have led the Jonathan Training twice since then in Ghana and at the end of this month we will be offering it for the third time in Bole over four Friday nights -Saturday 2 p.m. The Jonathan Training gives oral learners the strategic tools and resources needed to mobilize all believers in fulfilling the great commission of making disciples of all nations, irrespective of whether they are literate or not. People are taught how to apply scripture stories and discover transformational truths from these stories and commit to what they will obey and who they will share their story (testimony) and God's story (gospel) with the next week. The following week they are held accountable as to whether they obeyed what they said they would obey from the previous week's story and whether they shared their story and God's story with the people they said they would. The

training also helps attendees to identify "persons of peace" as Jesus taught his disciples in Luke 10 and Matthew 10, through which to plant simple churches (discipleship groups). The importance of household evangelism is also stressed where they are encouraged to identify family, neighbors, co-workers & classmates to share their story and God's story with. The training also emphasizes the importance of a clear vision as to why it is so important to make disciples and doing it in a way that rapidly multiplies, disciples making disciples that make disciples, churches planting churches that plant churches resulting in accomplishing the great commission in our life time. We are making disciples from the following tribes. The numbers under each tribe represents people from each of those tribes that have been baptized this year. Moses just told me of 16 more baptisms but I am waiting to see what tribes they are from before adding them to the report. P.T.L.!
