Isaac led fifteen men in June in a DMM training in the Tamale area at the ECG Church training center.

Isaac and Moses are now in Cote d'Ivoire for three weeks trying to set up a national team to lead DMMs there. This is their fourth trip there. They have discipleship groups going in Abidjan, the capital, as well as 12 hours north where Mali, Guinea, Burkina Faso and Cote d'Ivoire intersect. Part of their time will be spent in Abidjan and the balance of their time will be spent in the north. There are far more unreached people in the north than in the south. Moses is a good French speaker so he has been accompanying Isaac with the intent of following up without Isaac next year so Isaac can follow up in Niger and northern Nigeria after visiting there.

NEW PEOPLE GROUP NETWORK AMONG THE BANDA

There are two tribes associated with the Banda people, the Pantara & the Boahen. They tell us they don't understand each other's languages. The Boahen are more closely associated with the Ligbi and the Pantara with the Nafaanra. The Boahen are also associated with a tribe in Cote d'Ivoire called the Kolongo.

There is a curse between the two tribes that goes back many generations that says they cannot intermarry. This curse was made with a blood sacrifice. They say that anyone who tries to bring reconciliation will die and they have been doing animal sacrifices to try to bring that about, but there is much fear.

We talked with them about this. It is true, blood must flow, but there is a blood that is more weighty than the blood of animals that can take this away. There is a strong man [demon] that has made the curse. It is no longer the way of rams, but the perfect lamb of God that takes away sin. His blood makes the way where there is no way. He can bind the strong man and break the curse. You have to believe in the Lord Jesus Christ, repent of your sins and He will bring freedom from this and all sin.

"I am thanking God for allowing us to see His wondrous works on this trip. In the first village we went to we met a group playing Ludu, a local game. They asked us what we were doing and we told them we are people of God and we have good news. They said they didn't need that, but they directed us to a family they said would be interested. They weren't home, but someone passing by heard us and said this, God is what I've been waiting for. He said, he said I and my family want to accept this message, the husband, his wife & all of his children."
