

2020 Goals

International African Mobilization

“Glorifying the great IAM through Disciple Making Movements”

- By the end of 2020 we have a goal of 2000 new discipleship groups and 7500 new baptisms.
- By the end of 2020 we have a goal to have 4500 total number of groups with a total combined weekly attendance of 29,000.
- By the end of 2020 we have a goal to have segment, section, sub-section and village leaders recruited and trained to keep the span of care to one leader overseeing 10 group leaders.
- By the end of 2020 we have a goal to decentralize monthly meetings so Isaac meets with his segment leaders, Moses meets with his segment leaders and Joshua meets with his segment leaders monthly and then once a quarter all segment leaders come together to meet.
- By the end of 2020 we have a goal that the vision for financial sustainability plan will be implemented. Each group contributing a small amount monthly could begin being used to pay for motorbikes, expenses and travel expenses to launch DMMs in other countries.
- By the end of 2020 we will offer follow up trainings in Nigeria, Cote d'Ivoire, Gambia, Burkina Faso, Benin, Togo, Guinea and Zimbabwe.
- By the end of 2020 we will have done research trips to Niger, Mali, Mauritania and Egypt.
- By the end of 2020 we will recruit and set up national leaders to oversee the Disciple Making Movement (DMM) in the above countries.
- By the end of 2020 Isaac and Moses will begin functioning remotely coaching country leaders by phone, Whats App, messenger, Zoom and email. The bush fires are beginning to expand. May the whole African continent be consumed by the Disciple Making Movement fires and may God use Africans to finish the long overdue task of making disciples of all nations in our lifetime.
- By the end of 2020 begin integrating DMM practices with CHE (Community Health Evangelism)
- We will also continue meeting weekly with Isaac and Moses to plan training events, expansion discussions to other countries and the sustainability and health of the movements.

Team & Partnership Development

- Team Expansion
 - In 2020 host a visit from our Team Expansion Field Coordinator
 - In 2020 begin doing LIFTs via zoom
 - In 2020 host Team Expansion President and church leaders to visit our work and travel with Isaac and Moses to research launching a movement in Guinea
 - In 2020 we will continue working with Bobby and Mandy Graham and family regarding Permaculture Center, DMM and CHE
 - In 2020 we will continue working with the Odle family

Ghana Institute of Linguistics, Literacy and Bible Translation (GILLBT)

- Ghana Institute of Linguistics, Literacy and Bible Translation (GILLBT)
 - Continue developing oral tools for cell phones to be used by those who cannot read in their mother tongue to plant church planting movements.
 - Continue partnering with Jesus Film, especially *Walking With Jesus*, filmed in an African setting, five-part follow up video series to the Jesus Film.
 - Continue to build Wycliffe Bible apps for Ghanaian Northern languages – Gonja, Kusaal, Adele, etc.
 - Provide outside professional training through our Good News Productions, Intl, GNPI partner
 - Continue working on financial sustainability by developing a for-profit side to the recording studio.
 - Now that the studio is completed, we plan on inviting Isaac Masiga, GNPI's Nairobi leader, back for additional training.
 - To introduce the studio employees to the concept of Media2Movements via an online class.
 - To begin implementing Media2Movement media campaigns to begin making disciples through social media

Permaculture Training Center

- Oversee the Grahams who are in charge of the following relating to the Perm Center.
 - continue developing the center so that it will be resource center for community development as well as a training center for holistic training (DMM training, etc as well)
 - continue soil rebuilding – teach about and create a supply of compost with demonstration test sites
 - continue planting trees and living fence on back 6 acres to make it possible to add goats and provide food for the animals.
 - Install, test and demonstrate the benefits to drip irrigation.
 - Continue developing so that the center will provide sustainable food
 - Discover, train and implement clean water solutions for area villages
- Oversee the Odles and their work with BAM, schools, children' education

Of course all of these goals were set prior to COVID 19's attack on the world. But we are set up to continue with these goals remotely from the US until flight begin and we can return to Ghana.
