Terry & I along with Dean Robinson, Isaac, Kefas & Kassim have been taking a masters course called “Fidelis,” which is the Latin word for faithful. Although we are only in our 11th week out of 65, we have truly been blessed to be able to discuss much with our African brothers, who are so excited about what they are learning. I wish I had this course in my 20’s. It is awesome. The five components are: MetaNarrative, Disciple Making, Scripture Formation, Public Policy and Personal Wellness. Our friend and DMM’er, Frank Schattner developed the course. Isaac said, “My soul blesses God daily as I progress in the Fidelis course. I am growing in confidence in the face of a challenging task; the task to steward nations both in the religious and the secular world to move away from the status-quo. Several years back when I got the vision that God was raising me up to steward nations, I thought to myself, “I need a higher learning to boost my confidence in a world where people look first for a level of knowledge to determine maturity or one to lead”. But I also said to myself that I will not be taught by people who are not practitioners of what they teach, which I see in our institutions”, but the desire for a higher learning has been in me. Fidelis is furnishing me with practical knowledge of moving people away from being recipients of the mission of the church to being responsible for the mission of the church. Giving simple Biblical Narratives, and good life ethics have become practical and makes me see clearly ways to transform lives and society at large. Finally having been a DMM practitioner, and Mobilizer, Fidelis comes with a green light telling me to move on in that direction, and it kind of makes me stand on the shoulders of those who have gone before me so I can see farther in this journey of faith and mission.
