She travels with him and ministers to the women while Osman engages the men of the community. Augustina is from a region in Ghana where weaving traditional cloth is a skill she has learned well. The ministry supported a startup business for her to begin weaving in her new Gonja regional home and is teaching other young women to weave. She has five apprentices already and is starting the process of discipleship with them. She has already produced some cloth that is being sold in local homes. 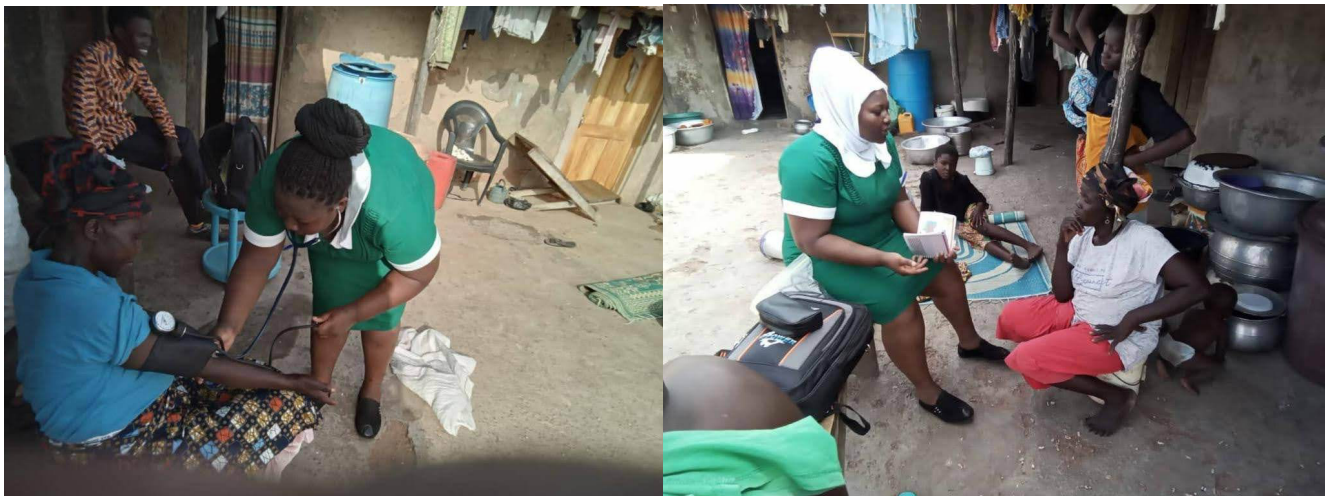
New Training for Disciple Makers...

Seventeen from Ghanaian DMM'ers went to the training and loved it. The group shared with some of our DMMers in Nigeria so they could take the training there. What a blessing.





The International African Mobilization (IAM) DMM'ers that attended the training have already begun implementing what they have learned in their ministry. Isaac says, "Our Ghana team members on medical outreach in Segment 1, led by two of our new guys Josh and James. We are introducing our teams to medical centers and as disciple makers with a skill in primary health care and would want collaboration with the health centers and they are happy with it. At least they have us going to remote places they find difficulty going."





New in The Gambia...

Isaac is in The Gambia. Here is what he writes about his trip so far...

“Praise God brother, God has given us great opened doors in the Gambia. We have a man in Gambia who got really dissatisfied with Church, but loves Christ. He gathers his wife and two children at home and they worship. He is praising God for connecting us with him and we are training him. He is a building engineer by profession and knows many people and villages. He has made a commitment to ignite a Movement and help the few seeker groups. He said to us "I don't need your money." All I need is for you to coach me on how to grow and multiply disciples.

New Women's team in Ghana...

Every week Isaac gives this team of seven women transport and food money to go to these communities. When they get there, they pray and go to different parts of the community sharing Christ.
