Women's Team in Fulfulso:

There is a team of women who go out each week. [Comfort, Akos, Amina, Amoeka, Sumaya, Samata, Paula] Two years ago, he came home from the farm, went in to take a bath and came out of the room blind, weak & paralyzed. He had been bedridden for two years and now his wife has passed. No hospitals or doctors had been helpful. One night he had a dream that women came in to his room and prayed for him. He was thinking that the witches had come to finish him off. This team of women knocked on his door saying that they had been praying for people and could they pray for him. He invited them in and said 'yes' pray for me and they prayed for 30 minutes for him. The next day he got up from his bed and sat down. He asked for his walking stick to be brought to him, which they gave him and he saw the door of his room. 'I can see. I can see.' He could also walk, see his wife, his children. He accepted Christ. He said, 'God is so close to us and we didn't know.' When the women heard what had happened, they were amazed. They had never thought that God would use them in a way like this. The man has an uncle in Tulewe who has asked for the DMM'ers to come see him.

Isaac has been training 40 university students in Tamale who are from 11 regions of Ghana. Isaac says they are smart, young guys, hungry for God. They see the darkness taking over their campuses in Ghana. They have never experienced this idea of disciple making. They are very excited and motivated to impact each of their regions with the gospel. In the Oti region there are three new groups and they are expanding into Togo which is their close border. The 68 year old, PhD holder of New Life College's principal attended the training. He made the comment, "We have wasted our time going. Now we are reaching out to households who are open to the gospel."

Jacob has moved into the Buipe Segment and now has 2 new groups.

Flooding all across the northern region is wreaking havoc and displacing so many people. Isaac's houses in Buipe and Alhassan Kura are full of displaced DMM'ers because of these floods. The problem is there is no clean water in Buipe. The city water is not flowing because the river is flooded where the water purification plant is located. Isaac is exploring solutions, i.e. borehole, tanks, purifiers, etc.

The DMM team going into Tulewe from Mpaha has to cross a larger than normal river to get there. They put the motorbike into a canoe to reach the village. Many people had come to follow Jesus when Tanner was living and working in the area, but since his departure, they have fallen away. Others have come in to show the Jesus Film, but never came back for follow-up. This team is now going in every week and the interest is high for following Jesus.

Joseph is going out regularly reaching out to the groups established by Joshua. He is bringing these leaders together, stirring them up for multiplication. Some of these groups are East of Bilisikura and some are West of Bilisikura. Others are in Old Buipe and villages NW of Old Buipe.

Sankaran Project Proposal – After the failed water project, they planned to start a group farm with the DMM'ers with each one having a portion. Many of these DMM'ers are undergoing persecution and need this resource. They are proposing a bull & plow to prepare the land, weed killers and implements. Isaac is planning a Farming God's Way project/training and will work with this team to bring all the elements together for this farming co-op.

Isaac and a mentee, Abraham Gyimah will attend GEMA conference in the month of November. Ray Mensah is the president of the organization at this time.
