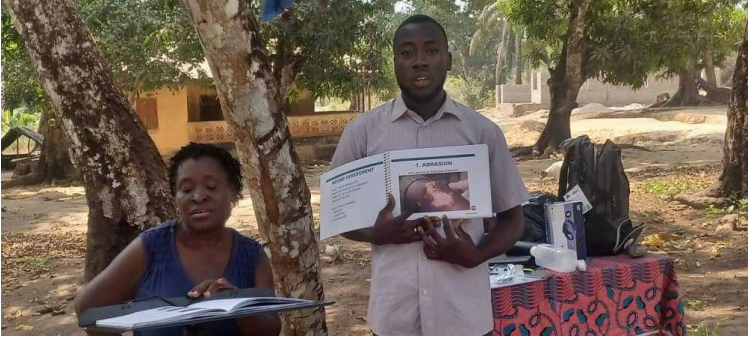
### Teach to Transform

<https://teachtotransform.org/> trained a group of disciple makers in Ghana and Nigeria in 2023 and in February of 2024 key leaders from those trainings traveled to Sierra Leone to help facilitate a training for the DMM'ers there. This organization equips partners around the world with medical and vocational skills they can use to share the gospel of Christ. They collaborate with partners who are serving in the most impoverished countries with the least medical resources and darkest spiritual needs. First aid techniques and simple diagnosis skills as well as birthing and well-baby care are part of the training. This enables the DMM'ers to go into new places with skills to provide for physical needs along with the good news of salvation.

No electricity, no mobile phone connection, and have to pay hard currency to stay connected to family and friends. We paid for connection on an hourly basis. Temperature 45° Celsius. I couldn't have my shirt on, and thank God this is a part of the world where no one has shirts on. Government had to close schools due to the heat. No roads, no medical facilities, just one primary school, and very little rainfall. I call it another planet. The day we arrived, we held hands and prayed and that night they received their first heavy rain for 2023 and 2024.

Looking up we receive and discuss divine truth

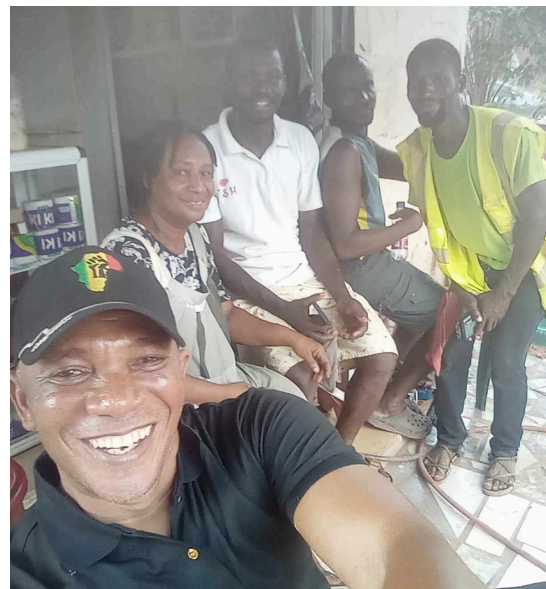
Looking forward we launch out on apostolic missions.

We intermittently prayed for the harvest and the Holy Spirit to empower us.

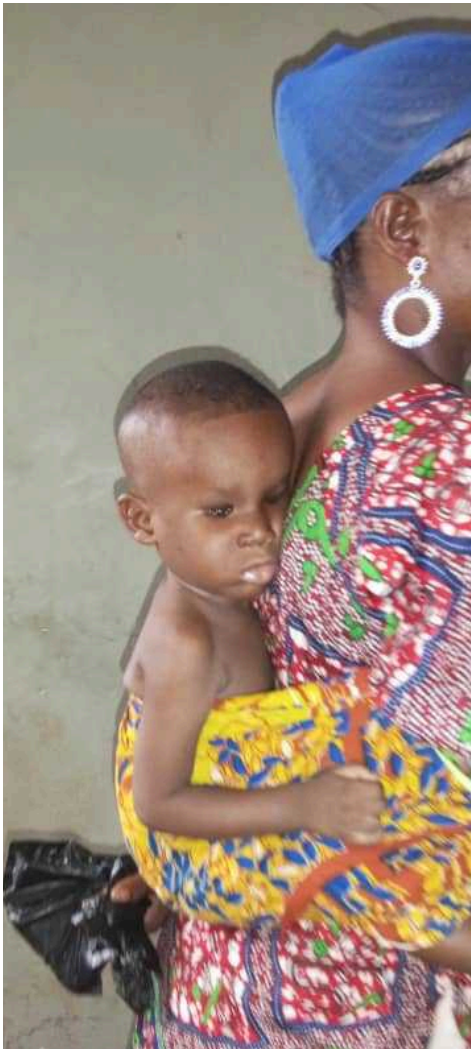
We listened to the Holy Spirit to speak to us. It was great!
