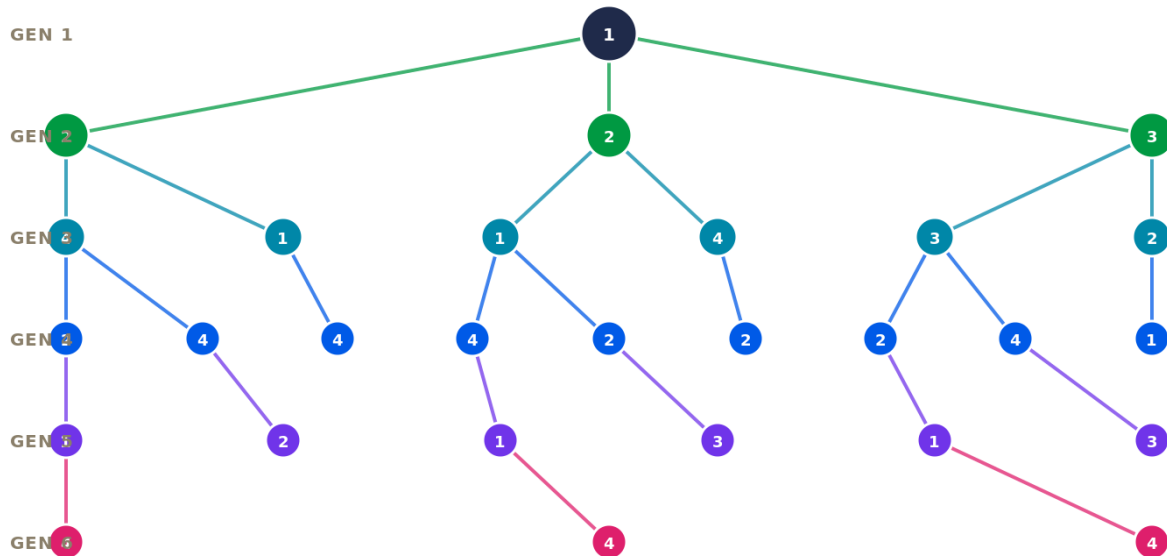


Generational Mapping

Visually tracking each new group and leader back to who disciplined them — generation by generation — so a movement can see its own multiplication clearly and celebrate it.

One Chain, Six Generations



Every circle is a group. Every color change is a new generation of leaders who were never personally trained by the person at the top. (Illustrative pattern based on real DMM Tracker data — names, locations, and numbers changed to protect leaders.)

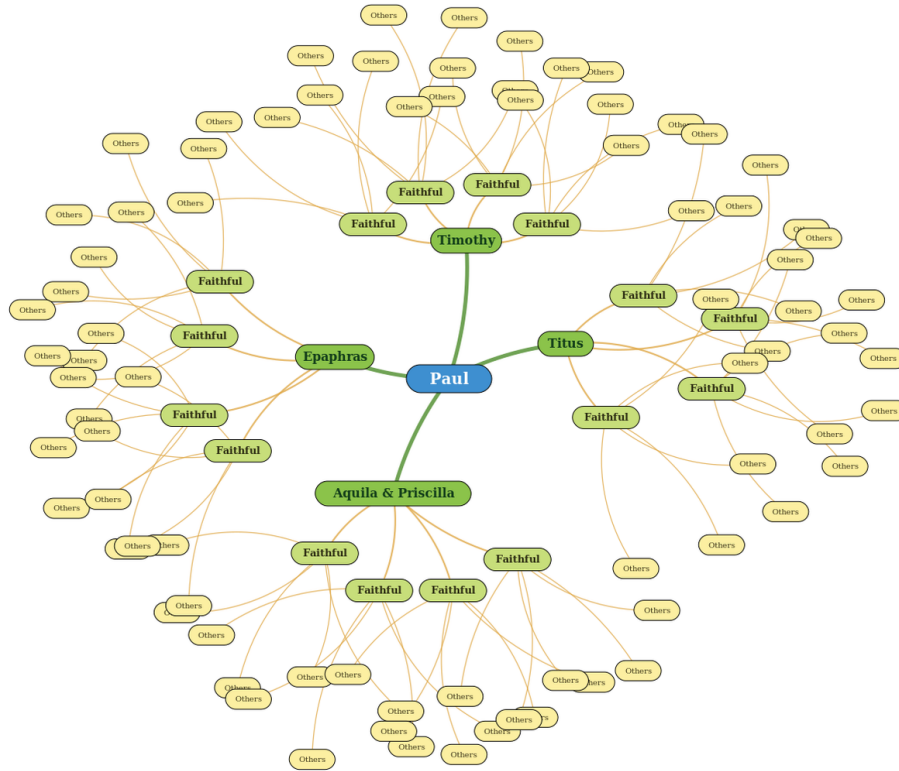
Paul's Gen-Map

4 Streams × 4 Generations — 2 Timothy 2:2

Paul's Gen-Map

4 X 4 / 4 Streams X 4 Generations

2 Timothy 2:2 / 2-2-2 Principle



Paul entrusted the gospel to four streams — Timothy, Titus, Aquila & Priscilla, and Epaphras. Each raised up faithful leaders, who in turn taught others. Four streams, four generations deep, is what roughly 100 groups looks like.

Use these maps with your own groups: who discipled you, who are you discipling, and who are they reaching? Track it, celebrate it, and keep it going another generation.

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
